Given the success of last year's conference in Amsterdam, which attracted more than 370 attendees from 28 countries, SEMANTICS 2018 is bound to continue a long tradition of bringing together a community from around the world. There will be presentations on industry implementations, use case prototypes, best practices, panels, papers and posters to discuss semantic systems in a broad range of regular as well as informal settings. SEMANTICS addresses problems common among information managers, software engineers, IT-architects and various specialist departments working to develop, implement and evaluate semantic software systems.

The SEMANTICS program will provide a rich mix of technical talks, panel discussions on emerging topics and presentations by people who make things work - just like you. In addition, attendees will have a unique opportunity to network with experts in a variety of fields. These relationships provide great value to organisations as they encounter technical challenges in any stage of implementation. The expertise gained by SEMANTICS attendees has a long-term impact on their careers and organisations. These factors make SEMANTICS the key event across Europe for a diverse community of industry leaders and academic experts alike.

The **Data Science Research & Innovation track** at SEMANTICS welcomes papers on novel scientific research and/or innovations relevant to the intersection of Data Science and Semantics. Submissions must be original and must not have been submitted for publication elsewhere. Proceedings should follow the guidelines of the Elsevier Procedia Computer Science format. Details will be provided soon. Papers must not exceed 12 pages in length for full papers and 6 pages for short papers, including references and optional appendices. SEMANTICS'18 proceedings will be published as Open Access by Elsevier Procedia Computer Science. Proceedings should follow the guidelines of the Elsevier Science format. Data Science Industry & Use Case presenters will be granted access to the entire program of the SEMANTICS Conference (incl. all social events) at a reduced rate. Additionally, presenters will have the possibility to discuss their contributions with an interested audience and exchange ideas how semantic technologies can be utilized for corporate and business needs more effectively and successfully. Besides that, the Industry Presentations at SEMANTICS generate a high visibility within the Semantics Community and allow you to meet interesting experts and extend your business network.

Industry & Use Case submissions should comply with the following criteria:

- Your presentation is relevant to industry and industrial purposes. It illustrates how data science and semantic technologies contribute to or improve existing businesses and / or generate new ones.
- The presented solution has already been deployed and / or has been tested in a practical

environment – at least prototypically.

- Your presentation is well-structured and does bring across its message.
- The topic is well described and covers enough explanations, examples, use cases, graphics, etc.
- Novelty: The topic covered is new to your industry not necessarily new to business in general

Every submission will be reviewed by the Programme Committee. All accepted submissions will be granted a presentation slot of 30 minutes (25 min. presentation + 5 min. discussion). Please take care to address the following aspects in your talk: Initial challenges, approach or methodology, success criteria / benefit of the solution, prospects and recommendations, a demo (if applicable). In case your presentation will be accepted, we will provide you with detailed information on organisational matters according to the selection of submissions and conference participation.
