# C) Special informations for presenters

#### Presenters in sessions

- All accepted submissions will be granted a presentation slot of 30 minutes (25 min. Presentation + 5 min. Discussion). Please stick to this time pattern when preparing your talk. This is the only way we can guarantee a smooth and satisfying programme and allow all conference participants to attend as many slots as possible without missing important presentations.
- Presenters should be in the room at least 10 min before your session starts and introduce themselves to the session chair, such that we can check whether all speakers are present.
- Please make sure that you have your presentation available on a USB stick and try out the presentation in the break before the session starts. Laptops will be available in the session rooms that can display PDF or PPT/PPTX. Should you prefer to use your own equipment we likewise advise to test the projector in the break before your session starts. In case you are using a Mac or HDMI-output bring an VGA-adaptor!
- As a backup, please send a PDF of your presentation to register@semantic-web.at.

#### Presenters for the LegalTech Track

#### Presenters of posters & demos

- Note that since the posters are displayed in the lobby of Hilton Waterfront, there will be very limited availability of sockets, so please have a **\*fully charged laptop**\*, in case you want to give some **demo** along with your poster.
- Posters and demos should all be set up in the beginning of the conference, so if you are a presenter of a poster please arrive early at registration on September 12th and mount your poster \*before the conference starts\*. We expect posters to remain mounted throughout the conference in all breaks in the open area of the conference, to foster discussion exchange.
- Poster dimensions are maximum A0 portrait and each Poster and demo will have an assigned poster stand. Posters will be pinned.

#### Presenters of industry posters & demos

- Presenters for <u>industry posters</u> (in case you have clicked that option in your submission) get in addition to the poster stand as described above also the opportunity to present in a session.
- Please watch out if your poster is mentioned in the wednesday session between 12:15 and 13:15. In this case you follow the guide for "**presenters in sessions**" in addition to your posters preparation.

# F) Registration desks / Collecting your conference bag&badges

This year SEMANTICS Conference has two locations. The registration desk on both sites will be open for registration/collecting your badges and conference bag, etc. at the following times:

Please note, in order to spare time at the registration desks, make sure that, if possible you make use of the **pre-registration service on September 10th and 11th** already. Especially, in case you arrive only on the main day of the conference, make sure to be present early enough, to avoid long queues/jams. Registration desks open grouped by first letters of your last name.

G) Access the area



The public transportation offers 5 subway lines, 32 tramways and about 80 busses (<u>Network Plan</u>). Tickets can be bought at the airport, at subway stations as well as at tobacconists.

**Vienna University of Technology**: You get there by following lines: U1, U2, U4, 62, 65 and Badner Bahn (station Karlsplatz) and by tramway D, J, 1 and 2 (station Opernring).

**Hilton Waterfront Hotel:** Take the U1 line to Praterstern. Change to the U2 line, heading in the direction of Aspernstrasse/Seestadt, to Stadion. From here, Hilton Vienna Danube Waterfront is within six minutes' walk. Take the Stadion exit (Stella-Klein-Löw-Weg) and follow the signs.



**Vienna University of Technology:** By car via the A1 (from the west) or the A2 (from the south). Follow the signs directly to the center of Vienna ('Zentrum') and proceed to Karlsplatz. Within and around the center of Vienna there is a short term parking zone (payment zone) requiring to park the car in a garage.

**Hilton Waterfront Hotel:** Take the A4 East Highway west, then the A23 toward Prague. Exit at Handelskai/Messegelaende and follow the Handelskai in the direction



of Messegelaende. Follow signs to the Hilton, turn left and access the driveway bridge to the hotel.

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**Vienna University of Technology:** The underground parking is close to the Technical University (about 200m): <u>Karlsplatzgarage</u>

Hilton Waterfront Hotel: The parking direct at the Hilton is about 22,- a day.
