The Posters & Demonstrations Track invites innovative work in progress, late-breaking research and innovation results, and smaller contributions in all fields related to the (broadly understood) Semantic Web. These include submissions on innovative applications with strong impact on end users such as demos of solutions that users may test or that are yet in the conceptual phase, but are worth discussing, and also applications, use cases or pieces of code that may attract developers and potential research or business partners. This also concerns new data sets made publicly available.

The informal setting of the Posters & Demonstrations Track encourages participants to present innovations to the research community and business users as well as to find new partners or clients and engage in discussions about the presented work. Such discussions can provide presenters invaluable input for their future work, while offering conference participants an effective way to network with other researchers and broaden their knowledge of emerging research trends.

Poster and demo submissions should consist of a paper that describes the work, its contribution to the field or innovative aspects. Submissions must be original and must not have been submitted for publication elsewhere.

Accepted papers will be published in [CEUR](#) proceedings. Papers should be submitted through EasyChair (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=semantics2018>) following the [Springer LNCS style](#) and should not be longer than four (4) pages, including references. In addition to PDF submissions, we also accept HTML submissions as long as they are compatible with the [Springer LNCS style](#).

Submissions will be reviewed by experienced and knowledgeable researchers and practitioners; each submission will receive detailed feedback. For demos, we encourage authors to include links enabling the reviewers to test the application or review the component.

This year we offer two sub-tracks in the Poster and Demo track:

- Posters and/or Demos **with an industrial focus**.
 - Relevant for submission that have an explicit reference to an industry application, industry use case or lessons learned from an industry project.
 - All the accepted submissions of this subtrack will be granted an oral presentation slot during the industry track.
 - All the accepted submissions of this subtrack will be granted space to place their poster and/or demo in the Posters and Demos session.
- Posters and/or Demos **with no industrial focus**.
 - Relevant for submission with no explicit reference to industry.
 - All the accepted submissions of this subtrack will be granted space to place their poster and/or demo in the Posters and Demos session.
